




Installation

Remove the top cover and unhook the tether wire.







A 3/4" conduit is required for routing the cables with waterproof


Install the cable gland and pass cables through it.







Package Contents









Attach the included alignment sticker to a preferred position. Drill holes on the wall and install the junction box. If space behind the wall allows, you may also pass cables through the wall.




Loosen and remove the camera top cover if applicable. (Using one of the supported cameras as an example)




Make sure the rubber seal is properly installed to the center hole. The outer rim of the seal must be through and cover the edge of the hole.




A: IFV Series
B: IBV Series




Pass the camera's Ethernet cable through the center hole of the box and the rubber seal.






9 Secure the top cover by fastening 4 hex socket screws.




Install the camera using the corresponding mounting holes with the included hex socket screws.





Open a live view page on the camera's web user interface and point the camera to obtain the desired field of view.

If installing a fixed dome camera, secure the camera lower dome.



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
